The City of Sugar Hill Plaza Security Patrol Actions Apr.21st, 2017 – Apr.27th, 2017

- The following actions are specific significant actions taken during normal patrols throughout the City. Plaza Security patrols the City on a daily basis and any criminal act is forwarded immediately to the Gwinnett County Police Department. Security officers request any illegal activity be reported to them and also be reported to Gwinnett County Police Dept. Plaza Security acts as additional eyes and ears for the City and provides assistance when needed; however, they are not a police agency.
- 04-21-17- The Officer made routine patrols in various parts of the city, including the business and residential properties and not neglecting the P.O.A.P.'s The Officer while on patrol observed a suspicious vehicle, a black Jeep Wrangler bearing Fl. plates sitting on the side of Pinecrest Road occupied on the Georgia Power powerline right of way. The Officer went on to check the Pinecrest Drive, Pinecrest Station and Crested View at Pinecrest locations and then returned to the suspicious vehicle of which was still sitting in the same spot. Upon investigation the Officer was advised by the White female driver that she had pulled over to call her Daughter who resided in the Pinecrest Station subdivision. The Officer advised her that he was just concerned that she was lost or stranded. The Officer then went back in service. The Officer then while on patrol in the First Avenue area observed a suspicious vehicle parked in the vicinity of the railroad tracks. Upon investigation the Officer was advised by the Gefficer went back in service after advising the subjects to remain in their vehicle for their own safety. The vehicle appeared to be parked a safe distance from the tracks. No other incidents were observed by or reported to Plaza Security LLC personnel.
- 04-22-17-Officer made routine patrols of both residential and business properties. This also

The Officer upon conducting a through area checks of the subdivision was unable to make contact with the subject.
