The City of Sugar Hill Plaza Security Patrol Actions Jun.29, 2018 – Jul.05, 2018

- The following actions are specific significant actions taken during normal patrols throughout the City. Plaza Security patrols the City on a daily basis and any criminal act is forwarded immediately to the Gwinnett County Police Department. Security officers request any illegal activity be reported to them and also be reported to Gwinnett County Police Dept. Plaza Security acts as additional eyes and ears for the City and provides assistance when needed; however, they are not a police agency.
- 06-29-18-Officer made routine patrols of both residential and business properties. This also
 included, but was not limited to the P.O.A.P.s. No incidents or issues were observed by or
 reported to security personnel.
- 06-30-18- The Plaza Patrol Officer made several patrols of both residential and business properties to include P.O.A.P.'s in search of nefarious or illegal activities. Finding none and having none reported to the Officer he concluded his shift and departed.
- 07-01-18-Officer made routine patrols of both residential and business properties. The patrols
 included but were not limited to P.O.A.P.s for suspicious activity. No issues or incidents were
 observed by or reported to security personnel.
- 007-02-18- Officer made routine patrols of all P.O.A.P.'s, not neglecting residential and business properties. No issues or incidents were observed by or reported to Plaza Security LLC, personnel.
- 07-03-18- The Officer made routine patrols of both business and residential properties looking for suspicious and/or illegal activity/s. No issues or incidents were observed by or reported to Plaza Security LLC, personnel.
- 07-04-18- The Officer made routine patrols of the commercial and residential properties. During these patrols were included the various P.O.A.P's. While securing Pirkle Park the Officer observed two vehicles at the Community Garden, the time was 0030. The Officer checked and both vehicles were unoccupied. The Officer secured the gates at the Suwanee Dam Rd entrance and returned to the Community Garden parking area and saw two subjects enter the vehicles and leave without incident. During these patrols no other incidents or nefarious activities were reported to or observed by the Officer.
- 07-05-18- The Officer made routine patrols of both business and residential properties to check for illegal activities. These checks included but were not limited to P.O.A.P.'s. At approximately 1625 hrs. the Officer received a call from Lt. Tate advising him to be en-route to the Buice School in reference to a break in. The Officer was advised to meet with Joe Sokenis and Tim Schick both are City of Sugar Hill employees and were securing the building. Upon arrival the Officer was met by Directors of the Actors Guild of who were cleaning up the mess. The Officer was advised that a person/s had made forcible entry into the building by means of smashing the windows in two exterior doors. After gaining entry the said person/s smashed 9-10 windows in the interior doors. They then gathered up furnishings and made a makeshift lounge in one of the class rooms. The Victims placed the activity between 1100 hrs. And 1530 hours on 05, Jul.'18. GCPD were called and generated a report. The area will be under a P.O.A.P. four times per shift until further notice. While securing the parking area at the Austin Garner area of Pirkle Park a subject had to be advised that at 2200 hours that. the park was closed. The subject then left without incident. At approximately 0015 hours the power on Buford Drive went out for a few minutes, cause was unknown at the time of this report. There were no other incidents observed by or reported to Plaza Security, L.L.C. personnel.
- NOTE: All shifts have maintained sporadic and numerous patrols and surveillance of the 1498
 Hillcrest Drive (aka the City Barn) location for unauthorized and or nefarious activities as a
 possible deterrent to future theft and /or damage to Sugar Hill properties.

- Multiple patrols performed throughout the following locations due to previous incidents: Pinecrest Station, Kendrix Ridge, Sugar Crossing, Hillcrest Woods, Duncan Town, Sycamore Summit, Frontier Forest, Park View, Sugar Woods, Pine Pavilion Estates, Saddle Tree, Lakefield Forest, Glens at Level Creek, Fairview Park, Sugar Hill Plantation, Richland Creek, Creekside at Pinecrest, Cobblestone Park, Spring Hill Plantation, Park at Barrington Estates, Avonley Creek, Cypress Springs, Bent Creek, Hickory Hills and Benfield Road, The City of Sugar Hill Splash Park. The House on Level Creek and the demolition site on First Ave. Patrols also cover all other

subdivisions. Added to the current list is the Buice School for a period of 90 days due to equipment storage for the Actors Guild. The location known as the Orr's Ferry House located at 6180 Cumming Hwy. This will receive two visits per shift until further notice...
