The following is a summary of actions taken during normal patrols throughout the City. Plaza Security patrols the City on a daily basis and any criminal act is forwarded immediately to the Gwinnett County Police Department. Plaza Security is not a police agency.

12-07-20 Mon – The Officer made patrols and had nothing to report.

12-08-20 Tue - The Officer made patrols and had this to report

**INCIDENT: ANIMAL ISSUE** – at around 5:56am Cpl Kelly-Boyd noted she sighted an animal that appeared to be possible a wild dog, coyote, or wolf in the City Hall Eagle Theater area. She noted the animal had gray and white mix of fur. Before she was able to get a photo the animal disappeared running off towards the empty lot area across from city hall and out of sight.

**INCIDENT: WATER LEAK** – The foot patrol officer at City Hall and Ecenter noted that a pipe underneath the Ecenter parking area appeared to be leaking. This leak appeared to be coming from a pipe near the hanging clearance bar and stop and entrance area to the parking deck.

**INCIDENT: DOOR FOUND OPEN** – The foot patrol officer for City Hall and Ecenter notes the cage for the Gator was left open while the gator it self was taken out. The officer closed the gate while no one was around to monitor the other equipment in the cage.

**INCIDENT: SUSPICIOUS ACTIVITY** – At 0550pm Sgt Parrish reported that the cable at the Orr Ferry House was found unsure and the cable draped across the driveway again. No suspicious activity involving the cable as both cable and lock where in tack with no signs of tampering or damage. Officer noted that on his way to the house he came across a deer carcass that appeared to be the victim of possible dogs or wild animals in the area. The body had signs of being picked at in places. Ofc notes the body was further back off the highway area along the trail to the house.
