The following is a summary of actions taken during normal patrols throughout the City. Plaza Security patrols the City on a daily basis and any criminal act is forwarded immediately to the Gwinnett County Police Department. Plaza Security is not a police agency.

01-11-21 Mon – The Officer made patrols and had this to report:

**INCIDENT: DOOR FOUND OPEN** – At around 03:12pm while making rounds foot patrol officer found M223 unlocked. Officer was unable to lock it but noted the room was empty.

He and Sgt King of Gwinnett Police Department proceeded to the E-Center to try to catch the six teenagers on the third-floor area. Once they arrived, the six teenagers had left the upper stair case area and had proceeded to the pond area. Ofc Dwi and Sgt King caught up to the teenagers at the pond and Sgt King instructed them all to call their parents to come and pick them up. Due to the age of the six teenagers no further information was gathered and no photos were taken during the event.
