The following is a summary of actions taken during normal patrols throughout the City. Plaza Security patrols the City on a daily basis and any criminal act is forwarded immediately to the Gwinnett County Police Department. Plaza Security is not a police agency.

03-01-21 Mon – The Officer made patrols and had nothing to report.

03-02-21 Tue - The Officer made patrols and had nothing to report.

03-03-21 Wed – The Officer made patrols and had this to report:

**INCIDENT: ALARM RESPONSE** – At 06:30PM officer was notified by off duty officer Sgt Parrish of the alarm at city hall going off. Upon response Officer and GWPD Officer Lopresto discovered 2 guests at the History Room conversing who were unaware that the building was closed for the day. Sweep of the building was made, alarm rearmed.

03-04-21 Thu – The Officer made patrols and had this to report:

**INCIDENT: SUSPICIOUS ACTIVITY** – At 03:40am Officer made note of an illegal truck and trailer bed parked in the Pull-out area by the tree to the left of city halls on Temple Dr. Officer noted that he later spoke with city personnel who informed him that they knew the owner of the vehicle who had done this previously and had been warned prior to not park in the location again.

03-05-21 Fri – The Officer made patrols and had nothing to report.

03-06-21 Sat – The Officer made patrols and had this to report:

**INCIDENT: SUSPICIOUS ACTIVITY** – At 05:01PM Officer reported the discovery of a Tent off Bailey Avenue approximately 100 feet from the fence in the cul-de-sac. Officer confirmed the location to be part of City property and proceeded to call for enforcement help. After calling 911 time Officer found Gwinnett PD officer Villacis who assisted with making contact of subject inside the tent. Stephen Taylor Brown was informed by on duty officer and GWPD officer that he had until 03.07.21 noon to pack up and leave the area. Subject was found to have departed sometime later.

03-07-21 Sun – The Officer made patrols and had this to report:

**INCIDENT: SUSPICIOUS ACTIVITY** – At 12:41PM Officer found that the Golf Course Maintenance Facility gate was unsecured though the main gate was secure. Officer found no evidence of forced entry to the key padlock. Officer notified MrQuagge who requested that the officer secure the gate.
